We further report that there was an application filed by Oriental Bank of Commerce [since merged with Punjab National Bank (PNB)] under Section 7 of The Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 against the Company before the National Company Law Tribunal, Cuttack Bench (NCLT, Cuttack Bench). On 28th November, 2022, NCLT, Cuttack Bench admitted the application and CIRP commenced against the company. Subsequently, by an ad interim order dated 21st December, 2022 of Orissa High Court, the admission was stayed. The ad interim stay is in continuation till date and the fact of such stay was disclosed in the limited review report for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December 2022.
